#### REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

#### **Constitution and objects**

The British Sub-Aqua Jubilee Trust is constituted under a trust deed dated 3 May 1978 and is a registered charity no 275835R.

The objects of the charity are to establish a Trust for the benefit of the community for the advancement of underwater exploration, discovery of safety health and science and for other kindred purposes.

#### Organisation

The trustees who have served during the year and since the year end are set out on page 1. Trustees are appointed by the board of trustees and serve for three years after which period they may put themselves forward for re-appointment. The trustees met three times during the year -5 March, 25 July and 24 October.
