

# **BSAC Council meeting**

## **09:00 Saturday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2023.**

### **1. Welcome & Opening Admin**

The Chair confirmed the meeting was quorate, apologies were noted. A HQ representative was present. The Chair approved the Minutes of the May Council meeting. Members were invited to declare any new conflicts of interest – none were declared. Members were also invited to lodge any topics for AOB, (item 7).

### **2. Actions from previous meetings**

### **3. Sub-committees**

A number of Council sub-committee reports had been submitted to the Council OneDrive in advance of the meeting, there was a short discussion on the relationship between the Articles of Association and the BSAC Code of Practice. The sub-committee chairs had submitted their team's composition to the Honorary Secretary as requested.

The CEO took questions from members.

The CEO, on behalf of the Strategy Chair, presented the strategy topic "*Plan for growing 19-35s*". The presentation covered:
